Know Your Drugs

It is almost impossible to find "pure" drugs on the street.

Even drugs straight from the pharmacy have binders in them.



Every time drugs change hands there is another opportunity for someone to alter them.

Unless the person you got the drugs from used a drug checking program they probably don't know exactly what is in their drugs either.

Binder/Diluter/Filler/Bulk
Inactive ingredients added to drugs

Possible Reasons:

- Diluted product is easier to measure and increases profits
- Stabilize active ingredients
- Binders to help pills hold together
- Change the speed the substance is absorbed
- Change the route(s) of administration

some fillers may not meet dietary restrictions

Examples:
Baking soda cooked with cocaine makes it possible to smoke (crack cocaine)
Starch is added to MDMA so it can be pressed into a pill

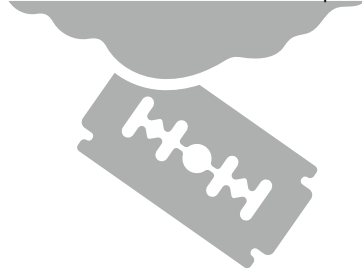

Adulterant/Cutting it/Stepped On
Psychoactive ingredients added to drugs

Possible Reasons:

- Make a batch seem higher quality
- Accidental Contamination
- Add a cheaper ingredient

Examples:
Meth is being stored in a baggie that used to hold fentanyl
Adding xylazine to fentanyl to make it last longer



Impurity
stuff in the substance that is because of the manufacturing process or the environment it was made in.

From the environment:

- Cleaning Chemicals
- Heavy Metals

From the Manufacturing Process:

- Plant matter
- Leftover chemicals
- Byproduct from manufacturing

Examples:
4-ANPP is inactive and left over from manufacturing fentanyl

Auto grade nitrous oxide often has dangerous solvents and may even have metal shards. Food grade and medical grade have impurities removed to make it safer.

Techniques:

- Food coloring
- Copying popular branding
- Make cheaper drugs seem like more expensive drugs
- Lying

Any drug can be made to resemble another, the only way to know for certain is to test it.

Examples:
Selling Meth and Lidocaine as Cocaine
Pressing fentanyl into "Roxy"(M30) pills.
